At the time of writing, coronavirus/Covid-19 cases are decreasing. However, until medicines and vaccines are available to combat the disease, it is very important to stay vigilant. Precautions such as hand-washing, mask-wearing and social-distancing are crucial for stopping the spread of infection.

For a time, it was very difficult to find face masks for sale, as mask manufacturing companies were overwhelmed by demand. Now, masks are beginning to reappear on store shelves and for sale online. Part of the reason is that some non-mask-making companies are stepping into the breach.

Sharp, an electronics company, is making disposable non-woven masks. A box of 50 is ¥2,980 at <<u>https://cocorolife.jp.sharp/mask/</u>>. Atsugi, which makes pantyhose, stockings, and underwear, began selling "Araeru Nuno Masuku" (Washable Cloth Mask) on May 15. The nylon mask has a pocket where you can put a handkerchief or gauze for extra protection. There are three colors, and they are ¥418 each at <<u>https://bit.ly/3gcFhVV</u>>. Mizuno, a sports gear company, is making washable polyester masks. They are available at the end of May in five colors for ¥935 each at <<u>https://bit.ly/3d2T0wR</u>>. (181 words)

More information New hand-held electric fan

The rainy season started in Okinawa Prefecture on May 11, so it's only a matter of time before the hot, muggy summer begins. Last summer, portable handheld electric fans began to be popular. Like every new and successful device, this one is developing by leaps and bounds.

At the end of May, Apix, an Osaka home appliance company, debuts "Mist Handy Fan," a hand-held electric fan that also sends out a mist of water to cool you down. It looks like a thick lollipop, with a round top on a long handle or neck. The air blows out of a window at the top, and mist comes out of a hole in the middle. The fan can be low, medium or high, and you can choose air and mist, only air, or only mist. If you fold the neck underneath the head, the fan can also sit on your desk. A rechargeable battery lets the device run continuously for two to five hours.

Mist Handy Fan is 23 centimeters tall. It weighs 186 grams, and it's available in white, blue or pink for \$2,980.
